Final Meeting and Multiplier Seminar in Nuremberg, Germany

Since our project will soon come to an end, we want to inform you about the last important event of the project, the European Multiplier Seminar that will be hosted by the German project partner PS:Akademie Nürnberg. We have invited adult education experts from many European countries that do not participate in the project in order to enable them to spread the project's results also into their countries and to contribute to a widest possible dissemination.

The highlight of the Seminar will be a lecture of Professor Dr. Ruut Veenhoven, titled "Greater Happiness for a greater number. What can adult education contribute?". Ruut Veenhoven is emeritus-professor of 'social conditions for human happiness' at Erasmus University Rotterdam, director of the "World Database of Happiness" and founding editor of the "Journal of Happiness Studies".

Other lectures will be from Professor Beutelspacher, founder of the Mathematikum Gießen, who will tell us why mathematic can make us happy, and from Mag. Klaus Linde-Leimer, about happines in adult education.
